# **Scientific Spirituality**

Scientific Spirituality deals with the scientific nature, perennial relevance, and universal truth of spirituality. Its theories and principles originate from a universal view that incorporates both spiritual (pertaining to Consciousness) and physical (pertaining to matter) entities within the scope of its explanatory framework.

In the views of Pandit Shriram Sharma Acharya - "The rigid convictions and practices of spirituality weaken their authenticity without scientific spirit and openness. The philosophy and teachings of spirituality without having a scientific approach lose their relevance and originality in the smog of blind faith and superstitions. Science also remains narrow and incomplete without incorporating spirituality. Science without spirituality has no bonds of values and so there is an obvious danger of its becoming aristocratic and apathetic."

Acharya Bhardwaj reviewed the holistic approach of the ancient Indian sages (*rishis*) towards scientific research. He said that science as viewed and developed by the *rishis* pertained to search of truth in an absolute sense and it was not confined only to matter or manifestation of Nature, which was perceivable through the sense organs; rather its domains of research encompassed the infinite expanse of Nature, consciousness force and eternal reflections of divinity.

### Science of Holistic Well-Being, Illumined Empowerment, & Blissful Evolution

A particularly advanced theoretical system for understanding the mechanisms of evolved transformation of humans is the theory of a sublime element of primordial life-force energy that exists at the threshold between consciousness and matter. Within Vedic (Hindu) philosophy, this sublime energy is called *Prana*. Within Chinese traditions, it is known as "Chi"; Japanese refer it as "Qi"; it is "Mana" for Polynesians, etc. The yogic methods and (sadhana) practices of Scientific Spirituality deal with gathering, conserving, raising, constructively using, and expanding this vital spiritual energy.

On the mental fronts the practices of scientific spirituality focus at emancipation, progress, expansion, and illumination of intellect and emotions. Successful progress of these leads to divine transmutation and evolution of the human self.

### Importance in Humanities & Social Sciences

Scientific Spirituality also pertains to integration of spirituality and social sciences. The methods and practices of *upasana*, *sadhana* and *aradhana* aim at holistic development of the individuals as well as the society. Pandit Shriram Sharma Acharya regarded scientific spirituality as the key to holistic management and progress of human life on personal, professional, familial and social fronts.

### Contribution to Sustainability & Righteous Development

Scientific Spirituality is an evolved science of mind that illuminates the intellect towards righteous path and awakens divine sensitivity in the heart (emotional core). It thus has promising potential as guiding light and force for crucial remedial and comprehensive measure/mode towards sustainability, global cooperation and holistic development against all odds of the present times.


